In April 2015, the Care Act (2014) introduced a new statutory framework for adult safeguarding, putting it on a statutory basis as for safeguarding children.

As part of its on-going drive to support the development of best practice in adult safeguarding work, the Hampshire Safeguarding Adults Board has developed a Safeguarding Adults Lead (SAL) Network. This is a network of 'champions' who take the lead for adult safeguarding within their organisation.
